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ADDENDUM 1

To all bidders under RfQ133/PU/IPNME/MOH

The Ministry of Health wishes to inform all bidders that the current Scope of Works has been revised as outlined below:

The current Part 3(b) states as follows:

- 2. Parts:** The Contractor shall furnish and replace all parts to meet SOW requirements. The Contractor shall provide new or factory reconditioned parts and components when providing maintenance and repair services as described herein. All replacement units, parts, components, and materials to be used in the maintenance, repair, and alteration of equipment shall be compatible with that existing elevator specifications; shall be of equal or better quality than original equipment specifications; shall conform to the technical specifications, and used in accordance with original design and manufacturer intent. Items not listed in the technical specifications shall be of acceptable industrial grade and quality. If the original manufacturer has updated the quality of parts for current production, parts supplied under this contract shall equal or exceed the updated quality. When disputes arise concerning material, equipment, and components selected for work items already accomplished, the Contractor shall, at no cost to the Government, remove, replace, and/or rework material, equipment, and components so that compliance with the Government 's requirements are satisfied.

This addendum provides for the addition of one paragraph as revised and in bold font below:

- 2. Parts:** The Contractor shall furnish and replace all parts to meet SOW requirements. The Contractor shall provide new or factory reconditioned parts and components when providing maintenance and repair services as described herein. All replacement units, parts, components, and materials to be used in the maintenance, repair, and alteration of equipment shall be compatible with that existing elevator specifications; shall be of equal or better quality than original equipment specifications; shall conform to the technical specifications, and used in accordance with original design and manufacturer intent. Items not listed in the technical specifications shall be of acceptable industrial grade and quality. If the original manufacturer has updated the quality of parts for current production, parts supplied under this contract shall equal or exceed the updated quality. When disputes arise concerning material, equipment, and components selected for work items already accomplished, the Contractor shall, at no cost to the Government, remove, replace, and/or rework material, equipment, and components so that compliance with the Government 's requirements are satisfied.

The Contractor before replacement of any parts during general, repair or breakdown service shall inform the Ministry of Health (MOH) of the costs expected to be incurred as a result of the replacement of a part/parts. The MOH will conduct an assessment of the proposed cost documents and

accept/decline in writing regarding the documentation provided by the contractor and provide justification of the decision derived at. Upon the costs being mutually accepted by the contractor and the MOH, the part replacement shall be carried out.
