### REQUEST FOR EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST (INDIVIDUAL CONSULTING SERVICES)

#### PREPARE A CONSOLIDATED ASSESSMENT REPORT ON THE IMPACT OF INTERVENTIONS UNDER ACTIVITY 2.2 TO THE OVERALL GCF-VCP

The Government of Samoa (GoS) has received financing from the Green Climate Fund (GCF) through UNDP as the GCF Accredited Entity (AE) towards the cost of the Integrated Flood Management to Enhance Climate Resilience of the Vaisigano River Catchment in Samoa (“Vaisigano Catchment Project”), implemented by the Ministry of Finance (MOF) and the National Designated Authority (NDA), and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services/technical assistance.

The GoS through the Ministry of Natural Resources and Environment (“the Ministry”) is planning to engage the service of a suitable Consultant (“Technical Assistant”) to prepare a consolidated assessment report incorporating findings from the overall review of major activities that have been implemented by the Ministry under Activity 2.2 of the GCF-VCP, including mapping characterization, important findings from the ground-truthing survey, lessons learnt, and recommendations to inform future related developments and priorities in the VRCA.

The Ministry now invites eligible Individuals (“Consultants”) to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consultants must provide a proposal demonstrating the capacity to meet the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services as set out in the Terms of Reference (TOR).
